Telephone Broadcast Notification System

Here is some specific information you should know about the School Reach Notification Systems, which helps our school personnel to notify households and parents by phone of school cancellations, an unplanned event that might cause early dismissal, an emergency, etc.

Caller ID: The Caller ID will display the main number for the school.
Example: Elementary 620-473-2461, MS/HS 620-473-2251,
Board Office 620-473-3121

Live Answers: There is a short pause at the beginning of the message, usually just a few seconds. Answer your phone as you normally would “hello” and wait for the message to begin. By saying multiple “hello’s” this will delay the message. Inform all family members of this process who may be answering your phone.

Answering Machines: The system will detect that your machine has answered and will play the recording to your machine. The maximum numbers of rings before hanging up is 5.
MAKE SURE YOUR MACHINE IS SETUP TO ANSWER AFTER 4 RINGS OR YOU WILL PROBABLY MISS THE MESSAGE – This goes for cell phones too.
